Tracy Sims:

Mr. Sims is a Quality Assurance Engineer at the U.S. Department of Energy in the Office of Science. His duties include leading and participating in a wide range of assessments at the six national laboratories that his office supports. He also works at DOE/NNSA with Ms. Van Horn on a volunteer basis. Mr. Sims has over 30 years of experience in quality program implementation and assisting companies in obtaining and retaining ISO 9001 certification.

Mr. Sims holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Ceramic Engineering from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He worked at several companies in the private sector in the manufacturing of refractory products (ceramic materials to line furnaces containing molten metal or glass) doing research and development, but quickly found that his passion lay in the area of quality assurance. He is current with four American Society for Quality (ASQ) certifications: Certified Quality Engineer, Certified Quality Auditor, Certified Manager of Quality/Organizational Excellence, and Certified Software Quality Engineer. He also maintains qualification under the DOE Federal Qualification Technical Program's Functional Area Qualifications for Quality Assurance and Safety Software Quality Assurance.

Christine Van Horn:

Christine works for the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) Headquarters but resides in the Chicago area. She is the Regional Response Coordinator (RRC) for the Radiological Assistance Program (RAP) Region 5, based at Argonne National Laboratory. RAP 5 has a region of 10 States in the Midwest. Christine has held the position of RRC for 16 years. Prior to this she worked at Argonne National Laboratory for 20 years. She held the positions of Senior Health Physics Technician, Radiation Safety Training Coordinator, Health Physicist and Deputy Emergency Management Officer. She has been a member of the RAP 5 program since 1980.

She holds a Bachelor's Degree in Health Sciences, a Master's Degree in National Security from the Naval War College and a Doctorate Degree in Theology. She is a Certified Emergency Manager (CEM) from the International Association of Emergency Managers (IAEM) and has continuously held this certification since 1987..
